Laying the foundation stone, *Sankustha:pana Maho:thsavam* for this Temple was conducted under the divine auspices of His Holiness and the temple is currently in operation in the house on the premises. The Presiding deities are Sri Rama Pariwar, Sri Mahalakshmi, Sri Andal, Sri Narasimha Sudarsana with Alwars, Bhagavad Ramanuja and Sri Manavala Mahamuni. Nithya Aradhana is performed for Perumal, Alwar and Acharyas on weekdays. Thirumanjanam to Lord Sri Rama Pariwar is done on every Saturday. We have devotees who regularly
